The estimated cost to rebuild a typical 1,400-square foot home in the UK is £197,000. The cost you'll pay, should you need to rebuild, depends on where you live. Those living in Yorkshire and the Humber pay the least to rebuild—a house in Leeds costs around £178,000 on average to rebuild.

How to calculate the rebuild cost. If you own a standard, brick-built home there are two ways to calculate the rebuild cost of your home. The first is to use the Building Cost Information Service's (BCIS) house rebuilding cost calculator. And the second is to hire a chartered surveyor who will carry out a professional assessment.

The rebuild value is the amount it would cost to rebuild your home from scratch if it was destroyed, for example, by fire, flood or a storm. Such events may seem unlikely, but unfortunately they do happen - according to Government figures for 2017/18, firefighters attended 167,150 fires.

A rebuild cost is a valuation on how much it would cost to completely rebuild your home from the foundations up, including labour and materials. The rebuild cost is usually less than the market value or sale price as it doesn't include the value of the land underneath - but that isn't always the case.

Breaking it down like this, at the lower end of the spectrum, a new build house might cost as little as £1,400 per square metre. At the top end of this range, you may be looking at more like £2,500, or even £3,000 per square metre. A typical, average price to bear in mind is probably around £1,800 per square metre.

A property's market value is based on many factors, such as it's size, location, parking and even the school catchment area. But a house that could sell for £250,000 might instead cost £125,000 to rebuild. And it's the latter amount that your insurer has to cover.

The rebuilding costs also include an allowance for full central heating costs, demolition and site clearance costs, architects' and surveyors' fees, and one half of the cost of rebuilding party walls in both terraced and semi-detached houses. Costs are based on houses or flats of an average quality finish and might need adjusting.

It usually costs anywhere between £800 and £1200 for replacing a chimney flue or lining. There are a few factors to take into account when calculating the cost of this job. The main two factors are the size of the chimney and the quality of the product used.

This cost is usually lower than your home's sale price or market value. Basing your policy on your home's rebuild cost will prevent you from over-insuring and paying higher premiums than necessary.
